



ARRANGEMENTS FOR A HUNT

Reservations for a hunt must be made at least 48 hours in advance. Advanced scheduling is to your advantage as **all fields are available on a first come first serve basis**. When booking a hunt, give us as many details as possible about your group, as this will help to make your day an experience instead of a trip. When making reservations be specific as to **DATE, TIME, NUMBER AND TYPES OF BIRDS TO BE LIBERATED, AND IF YOUR GROUP WILL NEED A GUIDE AND DOG**. Reservations may be made by calling (651) 439- 4287. We are closed on Mondays and all Major Holidays.

CANCELLATION POLICY

All scheduled hunts must be canceled 24 hours in advance. **Canceled hunts will receive a cancellation # you must have to ensure credit is issued**. Hunts that have not been canceled in advance will be billed at the current rate. Scratch hunting is available for members, but all liberated bird hunts have priority over scratch hunters.

CHECK IN REQUIREMENTS

All members and guests are required to check in at the clubhouse and sign the hunters log book every time you come to hunt or shoot (This is a state law). All guests are required to sign appropriate liability waivers. Every hunter entering the field must wear blaze orange (a minimum of a hat) and Safety glasses are required. All members are required to check out at the clubhouse before leaving the club. Non Toxic shot is required for all shooting!

DOGS & HANDLERS

All hunters are encouraged to bring and use their own hunting dogs. It is important to bring only well trained dogs. Arrangements can be made through the club to use a Guide and Dog for the safety and convenience of your hunting party. The fee for a dog and Guide is \$65.00 per hunt.

ALCOHOL & DRINK POLICY

Consumption of alcohol is prohibited while hunting or shooting. All beer, soft drinks and liquor are to be purchased from the clubhouse. All members and guests are required to obtain alcoholic beverages from the club bartender. We do not allow any alcohol to be brought on to the property. No alcohol until shooting is done! Our daily hours are 8:00 am to 10:00 pm. Hours may vary. Members and their guests may stay later than the posted closing time when prearranged with the bartender.

BIRD CLEANING

Birds may be taken home with feathers on to clean. All birds leaving the grounds with feathers on must be properly tagged for transport. Cleanly shot birds may be traded for pre cleaned, frozen packaged birds for \$5.00 per bird. We will not accept SBR's (shot beyond recognition) for cleaning. You may exchange your cleanly shot or cleaned birds for smoked birds or terriyaki pheasant sticks (when available) for an extra charge of \$5.00. Homemade Pheasant Pot Pies are available for one cleaned bird, plus \$20.00.

SPORTING CLAYS

Wild Wings of Oneka has two fully automated sporting clays courses and a new 5 stand operation added in 2008. Clay target shooting is available to members and their guest. Cost for a 50 bird round is \$22.00. NSCA certified instructors are available and shooting lessons can be scheduled during the season. Cost for lessons is \$50.00 / hour.

LUNCHES & DINNERS

Lunches, dinners and appetizers are available at the clubhouse for members and their guests. A price list is available upon request. Minimums of eight for appetizers (20 for the full appetizers), four for a lunch and six people for a dinner. Our specialty is our game dinner but other types of meals are available. Reservations are required for lunch or dinner. Reservations must be made at least 5 days in advance for staffing purposes. Without reservations, we do have snacks, sandwiches, chips, etc. available in our lower level bar area. Our dining room is closed on Sunday.

WILD WINGS IS A NON-TOXIC SHOT FACILITY

Because of our concern for our environment, and in an effort to leave the land better than when we came, only non-toxic shot may be used in the hunting fields or on the clays course. No lead is permitted anywhere on the club.

TERMINATION OF MEMBERSHIP OR HUNTING PRIVILEGES

The management reserves the right to refuse any member and his guests the right to hunt or shoot because of unethical conduct.
